HOW TO USE THIS PACK

1. Read the situation before the phrases.
2. Say each line aloud once slowly and once naturally.
3. Complete the short task without translating word by word.
4. Change one detail and repeat the dialogue as your own.

One useful goal

By the end, you can ask for help, confirm a booking, order politely, and check a route using short, natural English.

1. At the airport

Situation: You arrived early and need to find your flight.

MINI DIALOGUE

Traveler: Excuse me, where is Gate 24?

Staff: Go straight, then turn left after the cafe.

Traveler: Is it far from here?

Staff: No. It is about a five-minute walk.

Traveler: Thank you for your help.

USEFUL LANGUAGE

Excuse me, where is ...?

Is it far from here?

What time does boarding start?

Could you help me, please?

TRY IT

You cannot find your gate. What is the most natural opening?

MINI DIALOGUE

Guest: Sure. Is breakfast included?

Receptionist: Yes, from seven to ten on the first floor.

Guest: Great. Thank you.

USEFUL LANGUAGE
